All funeral directors are legally required to publish this Price List for a standardised set of products and services. This is to help you think through your options and make choices, and to let you compare prices between different funeral directors (because prices can vary).

## **UNATTENDED FUNERAL**

This is a funeral where family and friends may choose to have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person, but they do not attend the burial or cremation itself.

Burial (funeral director's charges only)

## **FEES YOU MUST PAY**

For an Attended or Unattended burial funeral, the burial fee1 in this local area, the typical cost of the burial fee for local residents is:

£360 to £2250

For a new grave, you will also need to pay for the plot; for an existing grave with a memorial in place,

you may need to pay a removal/replacement fee. In addition, the cemetery may charge a number of other fees.

For an Attended cremation funeral, the cremation fee<sub>2</sub> in this local area, the typical cost of the cremation fee for local residents is:

<sup>1</sup> This fee (which is sometimes called the interment fee) is the charge made for digging and closing a new grave, or for reopening and closing an existing grave. 2 In England, Wales and Northern Ireland, you will usually need to pay doctors' fees as well. This is the charge for two doctors to sign the Medical Certificates for Cremation.
